DETERMINATION OF THE FINAL SCORE:

The admission score is determined by the sum of:

- an assessment of the total CFUs earned in the relevant subject areas (link to subject areas), which will be carried out according to the table *Assessment of CFUs earned in the academic disciplinary sectors*
- an assessment of academic merit, which will be carried out according to the table *Assessment of academic merit (score awarded)* shown above
- the average of the grades obtained in Module 1 and Module 2 (minimum grade required in both modules: 18/30; Module 1 must be passed before taking Module 2)

EVALUATION OF THE FINAL SCORE:

- 70 or above: your application for admission is accepted
- between 50 and 69: you will be required to attend an additional interview aimed at examining the specific features of your academic background and any links with the degree programme (this interview will determine the outcome of the application)
- below 50: your application for admission is rejected
